One Day.

**Group Size:**

**Who Should Attend?**

All persons who will be required by their employer to undertake the role of mobile lane closures Supervisor for the mobile lane closures technique on motorways and/or dual carriageways.

**Course Aims:**

To provide delegates with the necessary knowledge to assist them in becoming a competent Supervisor of an Mobile Lane Closures team.

**Course Objectives:**

On completion of the session delegates will: -

- Understand the principles of Sector schemes, general health and safety at work, risk assessments and method statements associated with the mobile traffic management industry.
- Reference documentation relevant to the mobile lane closure technique.
- Training and assessment requirements for mobile lane closures personnel
- Vehicle and equipment specification
- Communications roles and responsibilities
- Mobile Lane Closures principles and practical techniques
- The types of work that require full mobile lane closure techniques and the limitations.

**Certification:**

On completion all candidates will undertake a multiple-choice question paper which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards will make certification for successful candidates.
