Who should attend?

Suitable for those intending to audit the standard of Temporary Traffic Management Operations and Installations against the applicable UK standards.

Course Aims:

The course aims to give learners an insight into the applicable UK standards, documentation, and legislation for Temporary Traffic Management arrangements, and provide an overview of the process that may be used in auditing these works, to enhance their ability in identifying, recording and reporting conformances/non-conformances, by effectively referencing and relating their observations to the applicable UK standards.

Course Objectives:

On completion of the course the learner should display and understanding of:

- National Highways Sector Scheme 12 Components
- Sector Scheme 12 Requirements
- The Temporary Traffic Management Process
- An introduction to Key Reference Documents / Standards and how these apply
- Auditing different stages of the Temporary Traffic Management process
- Questions to raise during National Highways Sector Scheme 12 Audits
- The effective Reporting and Validation of Audit Observations
- Recording Audit Results

Certification:

Upon completion of the course learners will be expected to complete an audit of a 'live' Temporary Traffic Management scheme, report and record the results in a suitable format and submit for verification and approval **within 2 weeks** of completion of the training course.
